**CA-09-08-24, 616 Normal Avenue, Replace wood siding with steel**

Staff Recommendation: Deny

While I understand that the upkeep of the wood siding is physically very difficult for Mr. Cramer the Commission has been deliberate in their effort to preserve the character of district and landmark properties by not permitting vinyl siding. Sec.15.16-2(E)(8)(a) of the code states:

*...The Historic Preservation Commission may approve cement fiberboard siding in dimensions appropriate for the structure and historic district; however, **vinyl siding will not be approved...***

**CA-09-08-25, 11 Broadway Place, Replace side door**

Staff Recommendation: Approval

The Pressburgers would like to replace their existing wood side door with a new wood door with tempered glass. The new door is an appropriate replacement in material and style.
